The incident may have started through the army mistaking the Karamajong firing their guns into the air for an attack. Please pray for all those affected. The road between Kotido and Abim is now blocked and those travelling from the north to the nomination meeting in Abim had to come via Soroti instead. 10,000 Ugandan soldiers are due to be sent to the region. Please pray that this will only be a temporary set-back and that the progress made towards peace and disarmament will be able to continue soon.
